TITLE: SENIOR CONFIDENTIAL INVESTIGATOR

GRADE/SALARY plus EXCELLENT BENEFITS: 32W - \$38,976

This is a Non-competitive, Civil Service position.

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: This is specialized investigative work involving the investigation of alleged crimes, interviewing victims of alleged crimes and witnesses, and gathering evidence in connection with defense or prosecution of suspects. Unusual judgment is required in making decisions concerning the pursuance of investigative activities in relationship to such alleged crimes. The incumbent performs related work as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Either:

- (A) Graduation from a regionally accredited or New York State registered college or university with a Bachelor's Degree in police justice, criminology or a closely related field **AND** eight (8) years of experience in investigative work or law enforcement** **INCLUDING** being the lead investigator in no less than twenty (20) "B" level felonies or higher **and** the lead investigator in no less than two (2) homicides; **OR**
- (B) Graduation from a regionally accredited or New York State registered college or university with an Associate's Degree in criminal justice or a closely related field **AND** ten (10) years of experience as defined in (A) above; **OR**
- (C) Graduation from high school or possession of a high school equivalency diploma **AND** twelve (12) years of experience as defined in (A) above.

****Law Enforcement** – defined as "the enforcement of Federal, State or local laws governing society with the right to make arrests."

NOTE: Verifiable part-time experience as defined in (A) above will be pro-rated toward meeting full-time experience requirements.

REQUIRED: Possession of a valid New York State Driver's License at time of appointment. This license must be maintained throughout appointment.
