## **MASON**

**DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS:** This is skilled work involving responsibility for journey-level performance of a variety of masonry repair tasks requiring a good knowledge of the trade. Immediate supervision may be exercised over the work of helpers. Does related work as required.

**TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:** (Illustrative Only)

Plans methods for accomplishing work projects;

Patches plaster walls;

Repairs brick walls and concrete block walls;

Points up brick and concrete block walls;

Lays new brick walls and concrete block walls;

Stuccoes brick walls and assists others in maintenance work.

**FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL**

**CHARACTERISTICS:** Good knowledge of the common practices, tools, terminology and safety precautions of the masonry trade; skill in the application of such knowledge to work assignments; ability to plan and work independently, ability to supervise subordinates, order supplies and do related paperwork; manual dexterity.

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:** One (1) year of journey-level masonry experience; or similar work.

**NOTE:** Verifiable part-time and/or volunteer experience will be pro-rated toward meeting full-time experience requirements.
